An electrician will be onsite to confirm all units comply with the safety standards. If you should require the services of an electrician you will be charged at the standard rate of fee for service.

Please provide the following: garbage can, recycling bin (if you are selling drinks in beverage containers). You must provide your own heavy duty outdoor power cords, mats to cover electrical cords, appropriate power bars and food grade hoses. You will be required to have the necessary permits and authorization.
